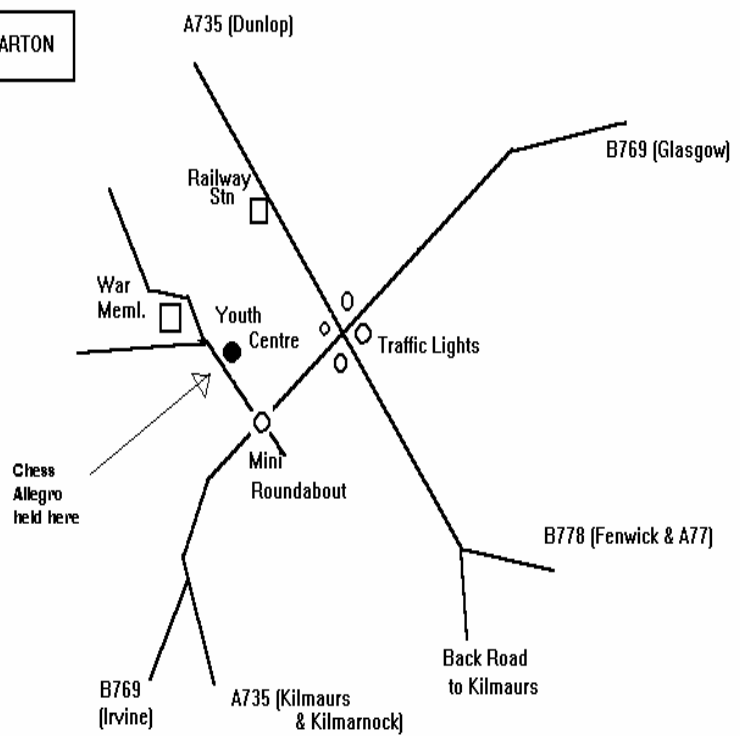

## Events

1. Open Open to all entrants
2. Major Open to entrants with an CS (Normal Play) grade of 1750 or less
3. Minor Open to entrants with an CS (Normal Play) grade of 1450 or less
4. Under 14 Open to juniors aged under 14 on the day and if graded, an CS (Normal Play) grade of 1100 or less.  
*Any Ayrshire player entering this section will also be considered for prizes in the Under 14 section of the Ayrshire Junior Championships*
5. Under 12 Open to juniors aged under 12 on the day and if graded, an CS (Normal Play) grade of 900 or less.  
*Any Ayrshire player entering this section will also be considered for prizes in the Primary section of the Ayrshire Junior Championships*

We hope you will stay for the Prizegiving which will take place as soon as possible after the tournament is finished. This should be at approximately 5.45pm.

This event will be held as a five round Allegro event played according to the Chess Scotland Rules Book including the 2005 FIDE Laws of Chess Appendix on Rapidplay games. Each player has 30 minutes for their moves in each round. The tournament will be run as a Swiss event - this means that everyone plays five games (it is NOT a knockout).

All results from this event will be submitted to Chess Scotland (CS) for grading.

## ENTRY FEES

Events 1,2 and 3	Adults	£9.00
	Juniors (under 16 on the day)	£6.00
Events 4 and 5	All juniors	£4.00

There will be a discount available for members of the same family playing in any section of the tournament. Each member of the family may deduct 50p from their entry fee. (Please note : family members are classed as brothers or sisters or fathers or mothers.)

The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without explanation and to make any adjustments necessary to ensure the smooth running of the tournament.

## PRIZES

All the sections in our tournament will include our usual prizes of First, Second and Third. We will aim to have a selection of other prizes such as Grading, Age , Best Ayrshire, Best local and also our popular Family prizes.

1. Open First £80, Second £40, Third £25 plus trophy/medals  
Best player overall : The Bonnet Guild Trophy
2. Major First £70, Second £40, Third £25 plus trophy/medals
3. Minor First £70, Second £40, Third £25 plus trophy/medals
4. Under 14 First £25, Second £15, Third £10 plus trophy/medals  
Also Ayrshire Under 14 trophy & Ayrshire Girls Under 14 trophy
5. Under 12 First £25, Second £15, Third £10 plus trophy/medals  
Also Ayrshire Primary trophy
